AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor
- 3 Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and
- 4 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of
- 5 vehicles and tractors, " further regulating the use of radar.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Subsection (d.1)(1) of section 1002, act of April
- 9 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," added
- 10 April 28, 1961 (P.L.108, No.48), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1002. Restrictions as to Speed.--
- 12 * * *
- 13 (d.1) (1) The rate of speed of any vehicle may be timed on
- 14 any State highway, including the Pennsylvania Turnpike System,
- 15 by officers of the Pennsylvania State Police through the use of
- 16 radiomicrowaves, commonly referred to as electronic speed meters
- 17 or radar: Provided, however, That the radar is visible for at
- 18 <u>least five hundred (500) feet prior to the commencement of</u>
- 19 timing.
- No conviction shall be had upon evidence obtained through the

- 1 use of radar apparatus unless--
- 2 (i) it is of a type approved by the secretary, and
- 3 (ii) it has been calibrated and tested for accuracy and
- 4 found accurate or adjusted for accuracy within a period of
- 5 thirty days prior to the alleged violation, and
- 6 (iii) official warning signs have been erected on the
- 7 highway by the proper authority indicating that radar is in
- 8 operation;
- 9 (iv) the speed recorded is six or more miles per hour in
- 10 excess of the legal speed limit.
