- Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An 2 act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and 3 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors, "further providing for exemption from registration of self-propelled golf carts. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- 9 Section 1. Subsection (f.1) of section 401, act of April 29,
- 10 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," added June 2,
- 1965 (P.L.85, No.58), is amended to read: 11
- 12 Section 401. Registration of Motor Vehicles, Tractors,
- 13 Trailers and Semi-Trailers Required; Special Permits for
- Nonresidents.--14
- 15
- 16 Self-propelled golf carts used for transportation of
- 17 persons engaging in the game of golf on any golf course, while
- 18 traversing any public highway during any game of golf, shall be
- 19 exempt from registration.
- 20 Self-propelled golf carts used for the transportation of

- 1 persons while traversing a public highway in a township of the
- 2 second class going to or from a golf course for the purpose of
- 3 <u>engaging in the game of golf shall also be exempt from</u>
- 4 registration provided the following conditions are met: (1) the
- 5 <u>highway is maintained by the township in which it resides; (2)</u>
- 6 the highway traversed is a two (2) lane highway or less; (3) the
- 7 speed limit on such highway does not exceed thirty-five (35)
- 8 miles per hour; (4) the distance traveled in either direction
- 9 does not exceed two (2) miles and takes place wholly within an
- 10 area defined for the purpose by township ordinance; and (5) the
- 11 <u>highway traversed is marked with signs advising of the operation</u>
- 12 of golf carts thereon.

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
