## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 13, 1915 (P.L.286, No.177), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act to provide for the health, safety, and 3 welfare of minors; By forbidding their employment or work in certain establishments and occupations, and under certain 5 specified ages; by restricting their hours of labor, and regulating certain conditions of their employment; by 6 7 requiring employment certificates for certain minors, and 8 prescribing the kinds thereof, and the rules for the issuance, reissuance, filing, return, and recording of the 9 10 same; by providing that the Industrial Board shall, under 11 certain conditions, determine and declare whether certain 12 occupations are within the prohibitions of this act; 13 requiring certain abstracts and notices to be posted; 14 providing for the enforcement of this act by the Secretary of 15 Labor and Industry, the representative of school districts, and police officers; and defining the procedure in 16 17 prosecutions thereunder, and establishing certain 18 presumptions in relation thereto; providing for the issuance 19 of special permits for minors engaging in the entertainment 20 and related fields; providing penalties for the violation of 21 the provisions thereof; and repealing all acts or parts of 22 acts inconsistent therewith, " changing the applicability of the act to members of volunteer fire companies, volunteer 23 ambulance corps, and rescue squads in certain instances. 24
- 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 26 hereby enacts as follows:
- 27 Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 7.3, act of May 13,
- 28 1915 (P.L.286, No.177), known as the "Child Labor Law," added

- 1 June 27, 1973 (P.L.70, No.30), is amended and a subsection is
- 2 added to read:
- 3 Section 7.3. Minor Volunteer Fire Company, Volunteer
- 4 Ambulance Corps, Volunteer Rescue Squads and Volunteer Forest
- 5 Fire Crew Member Activities. --\* \* \*
- 6 (f) All other existing provisions of this act and the
- 7 regulations promulgated thereunder affecting the employment of
- 8 minors shall be applicable in all cases, including the
- 9 requirements for employment certificates and the limitations on
- 10 hours of employment: Provided, That a minor sixteen or seventeen
- 11 years of age who is a member of a volunteer fire company who
- 12 <u>answers a fire call while lawfully employed and continues in</u>
- 13 such service until excused by the one acting as chief of that
- 14 fire company shall not be considered in violation of this act
- 15 for any part of the period so occupied.
- 16 (g) Any minor who is a member of a volunteer ambulance corps
- 17 or rescue squad may participate in training and any other
- 18 activity as provided by regulations adopted by the Department of
- 19 Labor and Industry BUT IN ANY CASE, DRIVERS OF ALL AMBULANCES OR
- 20 OTHER OFFICIAL AMBULANCE CORPS OR RESCUE SQUAD VEHICLES MUST BE
- 21 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
