AN ACT

Repealing section 7.1 (g) of the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.788, No.241), entitled "An act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste storage, collection, transportation, processing and disposal systems; requiring municipalities to submit plans for solid waste management systems in their jurisdiction; authorizing grants to municipalities; requiring permits for operating processing or disposal systems; imposing duties on and granting powers to
municipalities; authorizing the Department of Health to adopt rules, regulations, standards and procedures; creating an
advisory committee; providing remedies, prescribing penalties, and making an appropriation," relating to certain powers of the board of county commissioners.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Subsection (g) of section 7.1, act of July 31,
1968 (P.L.788, No.241), known as the "Pennsylvania Solid Waste
Management Act," added January 12, 1970 (1969 P.L.456, No.187),
is repealed.
Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
