AN ACT

1 Repealing section 7.1 (g) of the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.788,  
2 No.241), entitled "An act providing for the planning and  
3 regulation of solid waste storage, collection,  
4 transportation, processing and disposal systems; requiring  
5 municipalities to submit plans for solid waste management  
6 systems in their jurisdiction; authorizing grants to  
7 municipalities; requiring permits for operating processing or  
8 disposal systems; imposing duties on and granting powers to  
9 municipalities; authorizing the Department of Health to adopt  
10 rules, regulations, standards and procedures; creating an  
11 advisory committee; providing remedies, prescribing  
12 penalties, and making an appropriation," relating to certain  
13 powers of the board of county commissioners.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. Subsection (g) of section 7.1, act of July 31,  
17 1968 (P.L.788, No.241), known as the "Pennsylvania Solid Waste  
18 Management Act," added January 12, 1970 (1969 P.L.456, No.187),  
19 is repealed.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
