## AN ACT

- 1 Permitting the voluntary recitation of the Lord's Prayer and the
- 2 pledge of allegiance in public elementary schools at the
- 3 option of the school district.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. As a continuation of the policy of teaching the
- 7 history of our country and as an affirmation of the freedom of
- 8 religion in this country, a school district may authorize the
- 9 recitation of the traditional Lord's Prayer and the pledge of
- 10 allegiance to the flag in public elementary schools. Pupil
- 11 participation in the recitation of the prayer and pledge of
- 12 allegiance shall be voluntary. Pupils shall be reminded that
- 13 this Lord's Prayer is the prayer our pilgrim fathers recited
- 14 when they came to this country in their search for freedom.
- 15 Pupils shall be informed that these exercises are not meant to
- 16 influence an individual's personal religious beliefs in any
- 17 manner. The exercises shall be conducted so that pupils shall
- 18 learn of our great freedoms, which freedoms include the freedom

- 1 of religion and are symbolized by the recitation of the Lord's
- 2 Prayer.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
