AN ACT

Amending the act of December 20, 1967 (P.L.869, No.385), 2 entitled "An act establishing a uniform and mandatory system 3 governing the requirement of bonds to be furnished by contractors in the prosecution of any public building, or 5 other public work or public improvement, including road work; the rights and remedies of persons furnishing labor or 6 material in the prosecution of such public building, public 7 work or public improvement, including road work; procedure in connection with suits on payment bonds; rights of persons 9 furnishing labor or materials to a copy of bond; prescribing 10 11 penalties; and repealing other prior acts or provisions thereof inconsistent herewith, " adding the definition of 12 13 "payment for labor." 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 2, act of December 20, 1967 (P.L.869, 17 No.385), known as the "Public Works Contractors' Bond Law of 1967," is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 18 19 Section 2. As used in this act--* * * (4) "Payment for labor" shall include all amounts at which 20 the labor is recompensed, whether the amount is fixed or 21 22 ascertained on a time, task, piece, commission or other method

- of calculation, and shall also include amounts which the 1
- 2 <u>employer</u>, by collective agreement, has agreed to pay or provide
- 3 for union dues and fringe benefits, including but not limited to
- 4 <u>health</u>, <u>welfare</u> and <u>retirement</u> <u>benefits</u>, <u>vacation</u>, <u>separation</u> or
- 5 holiday pay.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
