- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the crime of theft by
- 3 government officials and employees.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, added
- 8 December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended by adding a
- 9 section to read:
- 10 § 3932. Theft by government officials and employees.
- 11 (a) Unauthorized disposal. -- A person is guilty of theft if,
- 12 being an official, officer, agent or employee of a government,
- 13 he disposes of or authorizes or permits the disposal of any
- 14 services, materials, supplies or labor belonging to, or paid or
- 15 contracted for by the government in any work or construction
- 16 whatsoever, whether gratuitously or for a consideration, for
- 17 private rather than public benefit, unless such disposal is
- 18 required by law.

- (b) Unauthorized use. -- A person is guilty of theft if, being 1
- 2 an official, officer, agent or employee of a government, he uses
- any portion of the property of the government for private 3
- 4 benefit without the consent of the government.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
