## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto, " providing for a referendum on the 6 school budget. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended by adding a 10 subdivision to read: 11 12 (q) Budget Referendum. 13 Section 696. Referendum. -- At the primary or general election immediately preceding the next fiscal year of the school 14 15 district, the board of school directors shall determine the will of the electorate with respect to the adoption of the school 16 17 budget for the next fiscal year.

The question shall be in substantially the following form:

- 1 <u>Do you favor the proposed</u> <u>Yes</u>
- 2 school budget for the fiscal
- 3 year 19 to 19 ?
- 4 <u>In case of a tie vote or if a majority of the electors voting</u>
- 5 on the question vote "yes," the board of school directors may
- 6 adopt the budget. If a majority vote "no," the board shall not
- 7 have power to adopt a final budget, but shall, at least monthly,
- 8 submit a budget to the electorate in special elections until a
- 9 "yes" vote is obtained.
- The budget finally adopted shall not, during the fiscal year,
- 11 exceed the total sum in the budget submitted to and receiving
- 12 the affirmative vote of the electors.
- 13 The board of school directors shall submit the school budget
- 14 to the county board of elections at least sixty (60) days before
- 15 the primary or general election preceding the next fiscal year
- 16 of the school district.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
