AN ACT

1 2	Amending the act of December 30, 1974 (P.L.1160, No.369), entitled "A supplement to the act of February 6, 1974
3	(P.L.80, No.17), entitled 'An act providing for the capital
4	budget for the fiscal year 1973-1974,' itemizing highway
5	projects to be acquired or constructed by the Department of
6	Transportation, together with their estimated financial costs
7	and the amount to be financed by debt, authorizing the
8	incurring of debt without the approval of the electors for
9	the purpose of financing the highway projects, stating the
L O	estimated useful life of the projects, and making an
L1	appropriation, providing for a highway project to be
L2	acquired or constructed by the Department of Transportation
L 3	in Luzerne County and making an editorial correction.
L4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
L5	hereby enacts as follows:
L6	Section 1. Clauses A and B of section 2, act of December 30,
L7	1974 (P.L.1160, No.369), known as the "Capital Budget Act for
L8	Fiscal Year 1973-1974, Highway Project Itemization Supplement,"
L9	are amended and subdivision XXXIX (Luzerne County) of Clause B
20	of section 2 is amended by adding a project to read:

- 24 Section 2. Sections 5 and 8 of the act are amended to read:
- 25 Section 5. Debt Authorization. -- The Governor, Auditor
- 26 General and State Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed
- 27 to borrow, from time to time, in addition to any authorization
- 28 heretofore or hereafter enacted, on the credit of the
- 29 Commonwealth, subject to the limitations provided in the current
- 30 capital budget, money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of

- 1 [five hundred forty-two million six hundred twenty-seven
- 2 thousand dollars (\$542,627,000),] four hundred one million eight
- 3 <u>hundred twenty-three thousand dollars (\$401,823,000)</u>, as may be
- 4 found necessary to carry out the acquisition and construction of
- 5 highway projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.
- 6 Section 8. Appropriation. -- The net proceeds of the sale of
- 7 the obligations herein authorized are hereby appropriated from
- 8 the Capital Facilities Fund to the Department of Transportation
- 9 in the maximum amount of [five hundred forty-two million six
- 10 hundred twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$542,627,000)] four
- 11 <u>hundred one million eight hundred twenty-three thousand dollars</u>
- 12 <u>(\$401,823,000)</u>, to be used by it exclusively to defray the
- 13 financial costs of highway projects specifically itemized in
- 14 this capital budget. After reserving or paying the expenses of
- 15 the sale of the obligations, the State Treasurer shall pay out
- 16 to the Department of Transportation or the State Highway and
- 17 Bridge Authority the moneys as required and certified by it to
- 18 be legally due and payable.
