REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, JULY 2, 1975

In the House of Representatives, July 1, 1975

1 WHEREAS, House Resolution 3710 has been introduced by
2 Representative Beard of Tennessee and is now pending in the
3 Congress of the United States; and

4 WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution 451 was previously adopted as
5 Pub.L. 85-403 in 1958 by the Congress of the United States, but
6 was not implemented during its five year limitation period; and

7 WHEREAS, House Resolution 3710 provides that neither the
8 District of Columbia nor the United States shall be responsible
9 for any expense connected with such memorial; and

10 WHEREAS, Private funds are now available due to the
11 generosity of those who recognize and appreciate the unfailing
12 patriotism and bravery of the "Screaming Eagles"; and

13 WHEREAS, The courageous men of the "Screaming Eagles" of the
14 One Hundred and First Airborne Division have distinguished
15 themselves in the service of their country as symbols of
16 American dedication, bravery, and devotion to duty; and

17 WHEREAS, It is only fitting and proper that unequalled and
18 unmatched heroism of the kind repeatedly displayed by the men of

1 the "Screaming Eagles" be duly honored and commemorated so as to
2 not be forgotten by the people of the United States; therefore
3 be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Congress of the United States of America
5 is hereby requested to enact House Resolution 3710 to authorize
6 the One Hundred and First Airborne Division Association to erect
7 a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs in honor
8 and in commemoration of the men of the "Screaming Eagles" of the
9 One Hundred and First Airborne Division who have served their
10 country in World War II, Vietnam, and in maintaining peace; and
11 be it further

12 RESOLVED, That copies of this memorial be dispatched to the
13 President of the United States, to the President of the United
14 States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of
15 Representatives, and to each member of the Pennsylvania
16 delegation to the United States Congress.
