- 5 WHEREAS, This broadcast made excessive use of literary
- 6 liberties to present a slanted, misleading and libelous
- 7 presentation concerning sport hunting in the country and in the
- 8 Commonwealth; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The citizens of this Commonwealth are acutely
- 10 disturbed at the questionable activities, procedures and
- 11 misleading statements used by the producer, writer and director,
- 12 John Drasnin; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 14 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania condemn the Columbia Broadcasting
- 15 System and its producer, John Drasnin, for the misleading,
- 16 biased and connived production entitled "The Guns of Autumn";

- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge each and every citizen of this
- 4 Commonwealth to express their feelings on this production to the
- 5 President of the Columbia Broadcasting System and the Federal
- 6 Communications Commission.
