In the House of Representatives, April 5, 1976

1       At the present time the American flag flies twenty-four hours  
2   a day above many private and public buildings yet it does not  
3   fly during the night hours over the Capitol Building here in  
4   Harrisburg.

5       It has been said that the flag flies on the moon day and  
6   night therefore why not fly it here on earth. In many State  
7   capitals the flag now flies over the Capitol Building every day  
8   and every night. We should follow this procedure here in  
9   Pennsylvania; therefore be it

10       RESOLVED (The Senate concurring), That the General Assembly  
11   directs the Secretary of General Services to fly the American  
12   flag over the Capitol twenty-four hours a day; and be it further

13       RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the  
14   Secretary of General Services.
