HOUSE RESOLUTION No. 262 Session of 1976

INTRODUCED BY RICHARDSON AND DUMAS, MAY 24, 1976

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, MAY 25, 1976

In the House of Representatives, May 24, 1976 1 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives 2 appoint a nine-member bipartisan committee, five from the 3 majority party and four from the minority party, to investigate Temple University's feeble administration of its minorities 4 5 program and racist allegations made against the university, such as failure to recruit enough black students and disproportionate 6 7 treatment of blacks as to hiring and treatment of maintenance, custodial, professional and administrative personnel. Such 8 9 investigation shall strive to have a strong community input to 10 its deliberations; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take 12 testimony, and make its investigation at such places as it deems 13 necessary within this Commonwealth. It may issue subpoenas under 14 the hand and seal of its chairman commanding any person to 15 appear before it and to answer questions touching matters properly being inquired into by the committee and to produce 16 such books, papers, records and documents as the committee deems 17 18 necessary. Such subpoenas may be served upon any person and

shall have the force and effect of subpoenas issued out of the 1 courts of this Commonwealth. Any person who willfully neglects 2 3 or refuses to testify before the committee or to produce any 4 books, papers, records or documents, shall be subject to the 5 penalties provided by the laws of the Commonwealth in such case. Each member of the committee shall have power to administer 6 oaths and affirmations to witnesses appearing before the 7 8 committee; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That within thirty calendar days after the 10 committee has made its report, the chairman of the committee 11 shall cause a record of all expenses incurred by the committee, or the members thereof, which are payable at Commonwealth 12 13 expense, to be filed with the Speaker of the House and the 14 Speaker shall cause the same to be entered in the journal 15 thereof. No expenses incurred by the committee or any member 16 thereof shall be reimbursable by the Chief Clerk unless such 17 expense shall first have been included as an expense item in the 18 record heretofore required; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings to the 20 General Assembly as soon as possible.
