In the House of Representatives, November 16, 1976

1 WHEREAS, The Department of Military Affairs is preparing to
2 implement a program of charging fees to the residents of the
3 Pennsylvania Soldiers' and Sailors' Home in Erie; and

4 WHEREAS, Fees have not been charged in the past to residents
5 of the home and the charging of such fees would constitute a
6 heavy burden on the facility's residents since it is not a full
7 care facility and since many of the residents do not have
8 substantial income or assets; and

9 WHEREAS, It would be desirable if the House of
10 Representatives, had time to thoroughly study the impact and
11 nature of the proposed fee schedule prior to its implementation;
12 therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
14 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urges the Department of Military
15 Affairs to suspend the implementation of its proposed fee
16 schedule for residents of the Pennsylvania Soldiers' and
17 Sailors' Home until April 1, 1977; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That as soon as possible after the House of
2 Representatives is orgainzed in January of 1977, the House
3 Committee on Military Affairs conduct a thorough study of the
4 proposed fee schedule for the Pennsylvania Soldiers' and
5 Sailors' Home; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings, together
7 with its recommendations, to the House of Representatives as
8 soon as possible but no later than March 1, 1977.
