## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
- 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
- 4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto,"
- 5 further providing for county public defenders to organize a
- 6 State association and the payment of certain expenses
- 7 thereof.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 440, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323,
- 11 No.130), known as "The County Code," amended August 11, 1967
- 12 (P.L.224, No.81) and September 1, 1967 (P.L.289, No.120) and
- 13 clauses (1) and (12) amended November 23, 1976 (No.239), is
- 14 amended to read:
- 15 Section 440. State Associations Authorized.--County officers
- 16 of each county may organize for themselves a State association
- 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) The county commissioners, together with the county
- 19 solicitor and the chief clerk to the county commissioners and
- 20 certain officers who are counterpart personnel in counties
- 21 having a Home Rule Charter or optional form of government.

- 1 (2) The county controllers.
- 2 (3) The sheriffs.
- 3 (4) The district attorneys.
- 4 (5) The probation officers.
- 5 (6) The registers of wills and clerks of orphans' courts.
- 6 (7) The prothonotaries and clerks of courts of quarter
- 7 sessions.
- 8 (8) The county treasurers.
- 9 (9) The recorders of deeds.
- 10 (10) The directors of veterans' affairs.
- 11 (11) The coroners.
- 12 (12) Jury commissioners.
- 13 (13) The county auditors.
- 14 (14) The public defenders.
- 15 Section 2. Section 442 of the act, amended April 28, 1961
- 16 (P.L.154, No.76), is amended to read:
- 17 Section 442. Deputies and Solicitors May Attend Annual
- 18 Meetings.--The deputy controller, the deputy sheriff, the deputy
- 19 register of wills, the deputy clerk of orphans' court, the
- 20 deputy treasurer, the deputy prothonotary, the deputy clerk of
- 21 the courts of quarter sessions, the first assistant district
- 22 attorney, the <u>assistant public defenders and the</u> deputy recorder
- 23 of deeds and the chief deputy coroner, with the approval of his
- 24 principal, and the solicitor for each officer, may attend the
- 25 annual meetings of his respective associations either together
- 26 with the controller, sheriff, register of wills, treasurer,
- 27 prothonotary, clerk of the courts of quarter sessions, district
- 28 attorney, <u>public defender</u>, recorder of deeds or coroner as the
- 29 case may be or in his place.
- 30 Section 3. Subsection (b) of section 444 of the act, amended

- 2 Section 444. Other Meeting Expenses Paid by Counties. -- \* \* \*
- 3 (b) In the case of county commissioners, county solicitor
- 4 and county clerk, county controllers, county auditors, sheriffs,
- 5 register of wills, clerks of orphans' courts, county treasurers,
- 6 recorders of deeds, prothonotaries, clerks of courts of quarter
- 7 sessions, <u>public defenders</u>, district attorneys, jury
- 8 commissioners and coroners, the portion of the annual expenses
- 9 charged to each county shall not exceed one hundred dollars
- 10 (\$100), in the case of the directors of veterans' affairs the
- 11 portion charged to each county shall not exceed fifty dollars
- 12 (\$50), and in the case of the probation officers an annual
- 13 membership subscription not exceeding six dollars (\$6) per
- 14 member shall be paid by the county, and shall be in lieu of the
- 15 expenses hereinbefore in this section provided for other county
- 16 officers.
- 17 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
