AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.598, No.206), entitled 1 2 "An act creating the Pennsylvania Minority Business 3 Development Authority as a governmental instrumentality and 4 as a body corporate and politic; prescribing the rights, 5 powers and duties of such authority; authorizing such б authority to acquire by gift or purchase; to make loans, 7 quarantees or other financial accommodations to minority 8 business enterprises, to borrow money and issue bonds therefor, providing for the payment of such bonds and giving 9 security therefor, prescribing the rights of the holders of 10 11 such bonds; providing that no debt of the Commonwealth shall 12 be incurred in the exercise of any powers granted by this 13 act; exempting the property and securities of such authority 14 from taxation; authorizing the authority to enter into 15 contracts with and to accept grants from the Federal 16 Government or any agency thereof; providing for the 17 examination of the accounts and affairs of the authority; and making an appropriation, " further defining "minority business 18 19 enterprise," providing for additional powers for the 20 authority, and further defining a quorum. 21 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 22 hereby enacts as follows: 23 Section 1. The definition of "minority business enterprise" in section 3, act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.598, No.206), known as 24 25 the "Pennsylvania Minority Business Development Authority Act,"

26 is amended to read:

1 Section 3. Definitions.--As used in this act:

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3 "Minority business enterprise" means a business enterprise 4 that owned [or] and controlled by one or more socially or 5 economically disadvantaged persons who are residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Such disadvantage may arise from 6 cultural, racial, chronic economic circumstances or background 7 8 or other similar cause. Such persons include, but are not limited to, Negroes, Puerto Ricans, Spanish-speaking Americans, 9 American Indians, Eskimos and Aleuts. 10

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Section 2. Section 7 of the act is amended by adding a l3 clause to read:

Section 7. Activities and Powers of the Authority,Specific.--The authority shall have the power:

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17 (3) To provide management and technical assistance to a 18 minority business enterprise, subject to such terms, conditions 19 and financial arrangements as the secretary or his designee 20 shall determine in his sole discretion.

21 Section 3. Subsection (a) of section 8 is amended to read: 22 Section 8. Loans and Financial Participation by the Authority.--(a) The authority shall not make loans, guarantee 23 loans or investments or provide other financial assistance 24 pursuant to section 7 hereof unless a [majority] guorum of the 25 26 board of directors present at a meeting vote in favor of the 27 action. [A majority of members of the board of directors of the 28 authority will constitute a quorum.] A quorum of the board shall be seven members. 29

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1 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
