AN ACT

Amending the act of July 20, 1974 (P.L.551, No.190), entitled 2 "An act relating to the right to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and establishing 3 means and methods whereby the right to practice medicine and 4 surgery and any of its branches and limited right to practice 5 6 medically related acts may be obtained, and exemptions 7 therefrom; imposing powers and duties on the State Board of 8 Medical Education and Licensure; providing for appropriation 9 of board fees to carry out the provisions thereof, and for the granting, revocation and suspension of licenses; 10 providing penalties for violations; and making repeals," 11 providing for internship. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. The section heading and subsection (d) of section 8, act of July 20, 1974 (P.L.551, No.190), known as the "Medical 16 Practice Act of 1974," are amended to read: 17 18 Section 8. Meetings of the Board; Examinations; Internship.--* * * 19 20 (d) Applicants for a license to practice medicine and 21 surgery who have been successfully examined by any agency

considered competent by the board and who can, in addition,

present to the board satisfactory evidence of having (1)

- 1 satisfactorily completed six months of intern training in a
- 2 <u>hospital certified by the hospital, (2) satisfactorily completed</u>
- 3 internship of one year under the supervision of a physician in
- 4 private practice, practicing general medicine or family
- 5 medicine, certified by such physician, and (3) in every way
- 6 fulfilled all the scholastic and other requirements of this act
- 7 and applicable regulations of the board, may, without further
- 8 examination, receive from the board, in its discretion, a
- 9 license conferring all the rights accorded by this act, provided
- 10 the applicant has paid a reasonable fee in an amount as
- 11 determined from time to time by the board, and further provided
- 12 that such applicant has not previously failed a licensing
- 13 examination given by the board.
