7	Section 1. The title and section 1, act of July 28, 1953
8	(P.L.676, No.210), entitled "An act providing for the observance
9	of March fifteenth of each year as Charter Day," are amended to

14	Section 1. The Governor shall issue annually his
15	Proclamation designating and setting apart March [fifteenth]
16	fourteenth as Charter Day and calling upon the people of the
17	Commonwealth, the public schools and other educational
18	institutions and patriotic, religious, historical and veterans'

organizations to observe the anniversary of the execution of the Royal Charter by King Charles II on the [fifteenth] <u>fourteenth</u> day of March, one thousand six hundred eighty-one, thereby creating the corporate legal existence of Pennsylvania, with appropriate exercises and programs, to the end that the establishment or birthday of Pennsylvania shall be commemorated each year.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
