1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the revocation or suspension of certain licenses and registrations; and repealing an act," further providing for a reduction in certain penalties.

13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. Subsection (g) of section 13, act of April 14,
15	1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug,
16	Device and Cosmetic Act," is amended to read:
17	Section 13. Prohibited Acts; Penalties* * *
18	(g) Any person who violates clause (31) of subsection (a)
19	[is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be
20	sentenced to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or to pay a
21	fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500), or both] <u>shall</u>
22	pay a civil fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100). The
23	<u>liability for and the imposition of such civil fine shall be</u>

- 1 <u>determined and imposed in accordance with procedures established</u>
- 2 by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
