- 9 under the provisions of the Pennsylvania Election Code.
- 10 The form of the question shall be as follows:

- 13 The county board of elections shall tabulate and publish the
- 14 results of the referendum within thirty days of the election.
- 15 The total number of supervisors shall not exceed five.
- 16 Section 2. Section 410 of the act, amended July 16, 1975
- 17 (P.L.73, No.43), is amended to read:
- 18 Section 410. Supervisors. -- Except as is otherwise provided
- 19 for the election of additional supervisors, [in townships having <-
- 20 a population of {three} thousand or more, ] at each municipal <-
- 21 election, the electors of each township shall elect one
- 22 supervisor to serve for a term of six years from the first
- 23 Monday of January next following his election.
- 24 Except as provided in section 514, no supervisor shall at the
- 25 time hold any other elective or appointive township office or
- 26 position other than township roadmaster or secretary-treasurer.
- 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
