## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
- 2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
- revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, " conferring upon first class townships the power to
  - regulate the depth at which water and sewer lines may be
- 6 placed.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331),
- 10 known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended
- 11 May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a section
- 12 to read:
- 13 <u>Section 2401.2 Depth of Sewer and Water Lines.--Townships</u>
- 14 shall have the power to regulate the depth at which water and
- 15 sewer lines may be placed.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
