AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the operation of motor
3 vehicle gasoline dispensing equipment by certain persons.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses), act of November
7 27, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes, is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 7325. Dispensing of gasoline.

10 (a) Prohibited acts.--Any gasoline station owner or operator
11 who permits any individuals, other than authorized employees, to
12 dispense gasoline by operating a gasoline pump shall be guilty
13 of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

14 (b) Offense defined.--Any individual, other than an owner or
15 operator of a gas station or an authorized employee thereof, who
16 operates a gasoline dispensing device at any gas station, shall
17 be guilty of a summary offense.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days and shall

1 expire December 31, 1979.
