AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting residency as a condition of employment for public 2 employees of political subdivisions.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. A political subdivision shall not enact, pass, or
- 6 promulgate an ordinance, resolution, rule, or regulation under a
- 7 home rule charter or otherwise, requiring a public employee, as
- 8 a condition of employment, to be a resident of the political
- 9 subdivision.
- 10 Section 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith
- 11 are repealed.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
