8	Section 1. Section 2005, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206,
9	No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and
10	amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), amended May 27, 1953
11	(P.L.220, No.30), is amended to read:
12	Section 2005. Power to Lay Out, Open, Widen, Vacate, Et
13	Cetera <u>(a)</u> The board of township commissioners may enact,
14	ordain, survey, lay out, open, widen, straighten, vacate and
15	relay all streets and parts thereof, which are wholly within the
16	township, upon the petition of a majority in interest of the
17	owners of property or properties through whose land such street
18	passes, or upon whose land it abuts, or without petition of the
19	owners of abutting property if, in the judgment of the board of

1 commissioners, it is necessary for the public convenience; and 2 the authority to open, widen and straighten highways with the 3 approval of the Secretary of [Highways] <u>Transportation</u>. Such 4 power shall include authority to vacate in whole or in part streets laid out by the Commonwealth where the same have 5 remained unopened for a period of thirty years; and also the 6 authority to lay out and open a street which will be a 7 8 continuation or extension of a street already open by an 9 adjacent city, borough, or township.

10 (b) For the purposes of subsection (a) "street" shall mean 11 and include any street as defined by section 102, either for or 12 intended for public use and shall include the cartway, sidewalk, 13 gutter or the right-of-way area, whether or not such street, or 14 any part thereof, is owned in fee by others than the township. 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
