## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act providing property tax or rent rebate to 3 certain senior citizens, widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with limited incomes; establishing uniform 5 standards and qualifications for eligibility to receive a 6 rebate; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue," further providing for the eligibility of widows and widowers. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Clause (6) of section 3, act of March 11, 1971 11 (P.L.104, No.3), known as the "Senior Citizens Property Tax or Rent Rebate Act, " reenacted and amended June 16, 1975 (P.L.7, 12 No.4), is amended, and the section is amended by adding a clause 13 14 to read: 15 Section 3. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 16 17 "Claimant" means a person who files a claim for property 18 tax rebate or rent rebate in lieu of property taxes and was

sixty-five years of age or over, or whose spouse (if a member of

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- 1 the household) was sixty-five years of age or over, during a
- 2 calendar year in which real property taxes or rent were due and
- 3 payable or was a widow or widower [and was fifty years of age or
- 4 over] or who had attained the age of eligibility during the
- 5 calendar year or part thereof in which real property taxes or
- 6 rent were due and payable, or was a permanently disabled person
- 7 during a calendar year or part thereof in which real property
- 8 taxes or rent were due and payable. For the purposes of this act
- 9 the term "widow" or "widower" shall mean the surviving wife or
- 10 the surviving husband, as the case may be, of a deceased
- 11 individual and who has not remarried except as provided in
- 12 subsection (c) and (d) of section 4 of this act. For the
- 13 purposes of this act the term "permanently disabled person"
- 14 shall mean a person who is unable to engage in any substantial
- 15 gainful activity by reason of any medically determinable
- 16 physical or mental impairment which can be expected to continue
- 17 indefinitely, except as provided in subsection (c) and (d) of
- 18 section 4 of this act.

- 20 (8) "Age of eligibility" means:
- 21 <u>50 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1978;</u>
- 22 51 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1979;
- 23 <u>52 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1980;</u>
- 24 <u>53 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1981;</u>
- 25 54 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1982;
- 26 <u>55 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1983;</u>
- 27 56 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1984;
- 28 <u>57 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1985;</u>
- 29 <u>58 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1986;</u>
- 30 59 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1987;

- 1 60 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1988;
- 2 <u>61 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1989;</u>
- 3 <u>62 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1990;</u>
- 4 63 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1991;
- 5 <u>64 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1992;</u>
- 6 65 years of age or older on or before January 1, 1993 and
- 7 thereafter.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1978.
