AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other 18 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " regulating maximum service 21 of members of professional licensing boards.

- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 25 as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended by adding a

- 2 <u>Section 428.1. Maximum Number of Terms of Board</u>
- 3 Membership. -- No appointed member of any board which is
- 4 <u>authorized to license members of any profession shall serve for</u>
- 5 more than two consecutive terms on such board, except that each
- 6 member of any such board holding office on the effective date of
- 7 this act may serve one term immediately subsequent to the term
- 8 being served by him on the effective date of this act.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
