AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " requiring the Department of General Services to conduct cost-life analysis for solar 21 22 emergency systems.

- 25 Section 1. Section 2401.1, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 26 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended
- 27 by adding a clause to read:

- 2 Services.--In addition to all other powers and duties set forth
- 3 in this act, the Department of General Services shall have the

- 6 (19.1) To conduct, prior to the construction of any new
- 7 State building, a life-cost analysis for the utilization of a
- 8 solar energy system as an alternative to conventional energy

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
