15	Section 1. Section 4, act of March 19, 1951 (P.L.28, No.4),

3	A State agency may, during an emergency declared by the
4	Governor, incur obligations for or purchase such materials and

7	assistance to victims of a disaster without complying with
8	formal bidding or other time consuming contract procedures.
9	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
