## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.788, No.241), entitled "An act providing for the planning and regulation of solid 3 waste storage, collection, transportation, processing and disposal systems; requiring municipalities to submit plans 5 for solid waste management systems in their jurisdiction, authorizing grants to municipalities; requiring permits for 6 7 operating processing or disposal systems; imposing duties on and granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the 8 9 Department of Health to adopt rules, regulations, standards and procedures; creating an advisory committee; providing 10 remedies, prescribing penalties, and making an 11 appropriation, "further providing for the powers and duties 12 13 of the department. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Clause (9) of section 6, act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.788, No.241), known as the "Pennsylvania Solid Waste 17 18 Management Act, " is amended to read: 19 Section 6. Powers and Duties of the Department. -- The 20 department shall have the power and its duty shall be to: 21 22 (9) Issue such permits and orders and conduct such
- 23 inspections as may be necessary to implement the provisions of

- this act and the rules, regulations and standards adopted 1
- 2 pursuant to the act. However, no permit shall be issued for the
- 3 operation of or in connection with a solid waste management
- 4 system whenever the proposed use would conflict with a municipal
- 5 zoning ordinance or, with respect to counties or municipalities
- subject to comprehensive plans approved by the department, the 6
- proposed system or its location have not been provided for 7
- 8 therein.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
