AN ACT

1 2	Regulating noncontrolled substances and equipment and providing penalties.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Short title.
б	This act shall be known and may be cited as the
7	"Noncontrolled Substances Reporting and Registration Act."
8	Section 2. Records of sales, etc.
9	(a) A person who sells or distributes the substances
10	enumerated in subsection (b) at wholesale or retail shall be
11	responsible for the maintenance of accurate records relative to
12	the acquisition, storage and distribution of such substances. He
13	shall record the full name, address (other than a post office
14	box number), occupation, telephone number and other identifying
15	data of those who purchase such substances. He shall record the
16	date, time, location of purchase and quantity of purchase and
17	the price paid for such substances. He shall note the manner of

1	payment	and for all purchases made with check, money order or			
2	bank draft, the name and address of the financial institution on				
3	the check, money order or draft and its number. He shall record				
4	the name and address (other than a post office box number), of				
5	signers, date of issuance and other identifying data and the				
6	registration number of the vehicle transporting the substances				
7	or equipment.

16	Section	3. Records of purchases, etc.			
17	The seller or distributor shall include in the records				
18	required by this act the full name, address, telephone number				
19	and occupation of the person from whom the seller or distributor				
20	acquired	the substances and the person involved in the storage			
21	and dist	ribution of the substances.			
22	Section	4. Equipment.			
23	The f	ollowing items of equipment used in connection with the			
24	illegal	manufacture or alteration of controlled substances,			
25	shall be	recorded and reported pursuant to this act:			
26	(1)	Three neck round bottom flasks			
27	(2)	Condensers			
28	(3)	Buchner funnels			
29	(4)	Pressurized reaction vessels			

(5) Suction filter flask and aspirator 30

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1 (6) Separatory funnels

2 (7) Hydrogenators

3 Section 5. Reporting.

4 (a) A person regulated by this act shall make available to
5 any Federal, Commonwealth or local law enforcement agency and
6 personnel, the records required to be kept by him.

7 (b) A person regulated by this act shall send quarter-8 annually to the Bureau of Drug Law Enforcement, Department of 9 Justice, a complete report containing the information required 10 by sections 2 and 3.

11 (c) A Federal, Commonwealth or local law enforcement agency 12 may not use information obtained pursuant to this act for 13 purposes other than the investigation of possible criminal 14 conduct.

15 Section 6. Enforcement.

16 A member of a Commonwealth or local law enforcement agency 17 may bring charges against a person for violations of this act. 18 Section 7. Penalty.

(a) A person providing false information to a seller or distributor under this act is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 and not more than \$25,000 or to undergo imprisonment for a period not to exceed five years, or both.

(b) A seller or distributor who violates this act is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$5,000 or to undergo imprisonment for a period not to exceed three years, or both.

30 (c) A person who violates section 5(c), is guilty of a
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summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
 a fine of not less than \$300 and not more than \$1,000 or to
 undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding 90 days, or
 both.

5 Section 8. Addition of substances or equipment.

(a) The Bureau of Drug Law Enforcement, Department of 6 Justice, is hereby empowered to add to the list of substances or 7 equipment enumerated in this act any substance or equipment it 8 believes is being used or could be used in the illegal 9 10 manufacture of controlled substances or in the illegal sale of controlled substances. Notice of such addition shall be sent to 11 every person engaged in the sale or distribution of such 12 13 substances known to the bureau.

14 Section 9. Registration of sellers and distributors.

A person engaged in the sale or distribution of any substance or equipment covered by this act shall register with the Bureau of Drug Law Enforcement, Department of Justice. He shall maintain updated, complete and accurate information with the bureau which shall include:

(1) the full name of the person or firm, his address
(other than a post office box number), telephone number and
all addresses of subsidiary or field offices or locations of
operations;

(2) the full name, address (other than a post office box
number), telephone number and occupation of all owners of a
firm covered by this act;

(3) the name, address and telephone number of any
subsidiary and field locations of operations of such a firm;

- 2 Section 9. Effective date.
- 3 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
