AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for registration plates for National
3 Guard members and retired National Guard members.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
8 amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1342.1. National Guard plate.

10 On the application of a National Guardsman or retired
11 National Guardsman, whose membership in the National Guard is
12 certified by the Department of Military Affairs, the department
13 shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle
14 as belonging to a National Guardsman or retired National
15 Guardsman. The registration plate shall have a white background,
16 shall have blue numbers or letters as the department may
17 determine, preceded by the letters "NG", and shall have the
18 words "NATIONAL GUARD" in at least ten-point bold type,
19 inscribed in red at the bottom of the plate. The special

1 registration plate may be used only on one passenger vehicle or
2 one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more
3 than 9,000 pounds. No fee shall be charged for this plate.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
