AN ACT

1	Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2	"An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3	special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4	primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5	and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6	imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7	courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8	imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9	revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10	repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11	elections," prohibiting any elected or appointed officer of
12	any political party or political body from holding any form
13	of employment with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of
14	its political subdivisions.

15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

16 hereby enacts as follows:

17 Section 1. Section 802, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333,

18 No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended

19 to read:

20 Section 802. Only Enrolled Electors to Vote at Primaries or 21 Hold Party Offices.--No person who is not registered and 22 enrolled as a member of a political party shall be entitled to 23 vote at any primary of such party or to be elected or serve as a

1 party officer, or a member or officer of any party committee, or 2 delegate or alternate delegate to any party convention. Except 3 for a delegate or alternate delegate to any party convention, no 4 <u>elected or appointed official of any political party, including</u> but not limited to chairperson, vice chairperson, secretary, 5 treasurer and committee persons, shall hold any elected or 6 appointed office of or accept any form of employment from the 7 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its political 9 subdivisions. 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days and shall 11 apply to any party official elected or appointed after the

effective date of this act.

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
