AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," authorizing the adjustment of the
6 school day schedule due to labor disputes.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10 as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended by adding a
11 section to read:

12 Section 1505. Adjustment of Hours Due to Labor Dispute.--(a)
13 If the schools of a district have been closed due to a labor
14 dispute during a school term, the school board may lengthen the
15 school day for the remainder of the term so as to provide a
16 minimum of nine hundred ninety (990) hours of instruction.

17 (b) Any school district adjusting its school day schedule as
18 provided in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be in compliance
19 with the one hundred eighty (180) days requirement of section
20 1501 for the purposes of all reimbursements and subsidies

1 provided to school districts by the Commonwealth.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
