HOUSE RESOLUTION No. 25 Session of 1977

INTRODUCED BY O'CONNELL, FEBRUARY 8, 1977

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, FEBRUARY 9, 1977

In the House of Representatives, February 8, 1977 1 WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States enacted P.L. 93-2 641 to assure "access to quality health care"; and 3 WHEREAS, The Congress sought to end the "maldistribution of 4 health care facilities and manpower"; and 5 WHEREAS, The Congress sought to increase appropriate alternative levels of care such as intermediate care in place of 6 7 costly inpatient hospital care; and 8 WHEREAS, In the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, these noble 9 goals are not being met; and 10 WHEREAS, The local health service agencies are stifling those 11 who seek to expand needed long-term services outside of 12 hospitals; and 13 WHEREAS, This is impacting in a negative way the cost and 14 quality of care being provided to the citizens of the 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; therefore be it 16 RESOLVED (the Senate Concurring), That the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of 17 18 the United States to evaluate the "National Health Planning and

Resources Development Act of 1974" and the health services 1 2 agencies created thereby; and be it further

RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to 3 the presiding officer of each House of Congress of the United 4 5 States and to each Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania 6 in the Congress of the United States.
