INTRODUCED BY PRATT, F. TAYLOR AND ARTHURS, JUNE 14, 1977

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, JUNE 15, 1977

In the House of Representatives, June 14, 1977

1 WHEREAS, For numerous years the Bureau of Professional and
2 Occupational Affairs of the Department of State has experienced
3 difficulties in discharging its statutory duties due to
4 budgetary problems and a lack of staff size in relation to those
5 duties; and

6 WHEREAS, Those licensed professionals, whose licenses are
7 administered by the bureau, have experienced detrimental effects
8 because of these difficulties and have in turn passed on a
9 detrimental effect to the citizens of this Commonwealth;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
12 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania directs the Joint State
13 Government Commission to appoint a task force to conduct a
14 comprehensive review of the structure, procedures, rules and
15 regulations of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational
16 Affairs of the Department of State for the purpose of developing
17 recommendations for improvements in the current policies or law;
18 and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission shall
2 make a complete report of its findings, together with
3 recommendations for appropriate action, to the General Assembly
4 within nine months of the approval of this resolution.
