## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, removing prohibitions on the use of studded tires
- during certain periods and prescribing penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4525 of Title 75, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 4525. Tire equipment and traction surfaces.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- No vehicle shall be operated on the
- 11 highway unless the vehicle is equipped with tires of a type,
- 12 size and construction approved by the department for the vehicle
- 13 and unless the tires are in a safe operating condition as
- 14 determined in accordance with regulations of the department.
- 15 (b) Vehicles not equipped with pneumatic tires.--It is
- 16 unlawful for any person to operate or move, or cause or permit
- 17 to be moved, in contact with any highway any vehicle equipped
- 18 with traction or road contact surfaces other than pneumatic

- 1 tires unless of a type, size and construction permitted by
- 2 regulations of the department and unless the movement is made
- 3 under specific conditions allowed by regulations of the
- 4 department.
- 5 (c) Tire studs.--[No vehicle having tires containing studs
- 6 shall be driven on any highway.] Tires in which ice grips or
- 7 tire studs of wear resisting material have been installed which
- 8 provide resiliency upon contact with the road and which have
- 9 projections not exceeding two thirty-seconds of an inch beyond
- 10 the tread of the traction surface of the tire shall be permitted
- 11 between November 1 of each year and April 30 of the following
- 12 year. The Governor may by executive order extend the time tires
- 13 with ice grips or tire studs may be used when highway conditions
- 14 are such that such tires would be a safety factor in traveling
- 15 <u>Commonwealth highways</u>. The use of tires with ice grips or tire
- 16 studs contrary to the provisions of this subsection shall be
- 17 unlawful.
- 18 (d) Tire chains.--Tires chains may be temporarily used on
- 19 vehicles during periods of snow and ice emergency if they are in
- 20 conformance with regulations promulgated by the department.
- 21 <u>(e) Penalty.--</u>
- 22 (1) Any person violating the provisions of subsection
- 23 (c) shall be quilty of a summary offense and upon conviction
- thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine as indicated in
- 25 <u>paragraph (2) and in default of payment thereof, shall</u>
- 26 <u>undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days.</u>
- 27 (2) Fines for violation of subsection (c) shall be
- 28 <u>determined from the following chart based on the period of</u>
- 29 <u>unauthorized use:</u>
- 30 May 1 to May 31 \$35

1		June 1 to June 30	<u>45</u>
2		July 1 to July 31	<u>55</u>
3		August 1 to August 31	<u>55</u>
4		September 1 to September 30	<u>55</u>
5		October 1 to October 31	<u>55</u>
