AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 5, 1933 (P.L.364, No.106), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act relating to corporations; defining and 3 providing for the organization, merger, consolidation, reorganization, winding up and dissolution of certain 4 5 corporations for profit; conferring certain rights, powers, 6 duties and immunities upon them and their officers and shareholders; prescribing the conditions on which such 7 8 corporations may exercise their powers; providing for the 9 inclusion of certain existing corporations and associations 10 within the provisions of this act; prescribing the terms and conditions upon which certain foreign corporations may be 11 admitted, or may continue, to do business within the 12 13 Commonwealth; conferring powers and imposing duties on the 14 courts of common pleas, and certain State departments, commissions, and officers; authorizing certain State 15 16 departments, boards, commissions, or officers to collect fees for services required to be rendered by this act; imposing 17 18 penalties; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts 19 relating to corporations and other entities," requiring the 20 annual filing of certain information. 21 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 22 hereby enacts as follows: 23 Section 1. The act of May 5, 1933 (P.L.364, No.106), known as the "Business Corporation Law," is amended by adding sections 25 to read: 26 Section 411. Annual Disclosure of Directors and Officers .--
- 27 Every business corporation shall annually file with the

- 1 Department of State a complete listing of the current officers
- 2 and directors of the corporation and of every other individual
- 3 who held such office or position during the preceding year. The
- 4 <u>department shall fix by regulation the manner and date when such</u>
- 5 <u>information shall be filed.</u>
- 6 <u>Section 1017. Annual Disclosure of Directors and Officers.--</u>
- 7 Every foreign corporation shall annually file with the
- 8 Department of State a complete listing of its officers and
- 9 <u>directors in the same manner as domestic business corporations</u>
- 10 <u>are required to file such information pursuant to section 411.</u>
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
