8	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:

11	(c) Limitations on nonstate serviceCreditable nonstate
12	service credit shall be limited to:
13	(1) intervening military service;
14	(2) other military service not exceeding five years;
15	(3) service in any public school or public educational
16	institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in
17	any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United
18	States; or service as an administrator, teacher, or

instructor in the field of education for any agency or 1 2 department of the government of the United States, whether or 3 not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United States, the total of such service not exceeding the lesser of 4 5 ten years or the number of years of active membership in the system, as an officer or employee of the Department of 6 7 Education or as an administrator, teacher, or instructor 8 employed in any State-owned educational institution or The 9 Pennsylvania State University; [or]

10 (4) previous service with a governmental agency other 11 than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was 12 terminated because of the transfer by statute of the 13 administration of such service or of the entire agency to the 14 Commonwealth; or

15 (5) previous service as a State assignee working within 16 and under supervision of a State agency as a result of a 17 grant by a governmental agency other than the Commonwealth 18 provided such person is later employed by that State agency. 19 * * *
