5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
6	hereby enacts as follows:	
7	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known	<—
8	as the "Public Welfare Code," is amended by adding a section to	
9	read :	
10	Section 443.7. Prior Authorization. The department may	
11	develop regulations requiring prior authorization of medical	
12	equipment, prescription drugs, oxygen, supportive braces,	
13	specific dental services and orthopedic shoes, but not limited	
14	thereto. Such regulations may establish procedures for issuing	
15	prior authorization at whatever administrative level the	
16	department through the secretary deems appropriate.	
17	Appropriateness shall be determined by the secretary after	

18 hearings have been held and public imput is received.

SECTION 1. SUBSECTION (E) OF SECTION 443.6, ACT OF JUNE 13,
1967 (P.L.31, NO.21) KNOWN AS THE "PUBLIC WELFARE CODE," ADDED
SEPTEMBER 26, 1978 (P.L.769, NO.146), IS AMENDED TO READ:
SECTION 443.6. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
ITEMS AND SERVICES.--

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(E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 7 8 THIS SECTION AND SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE FOR PRIOR 9 AUTHORIZATION. SUCH REGULATIONS MAY ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR 10 ISSUING PRIOR AUTHORIZATION AT WHATEVER ADMINISTRATIVE LEVEL THE 11 DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE SECRETARY DEEMS APPROPRIATE. 12 APPROPRIATENESS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY AFTER 13 HEARINGS HAVE BEEN HELD AND PUBLIC INPUT IS RECEIVED. PROCEDURES 14 ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE 15 AUTHORIZATION WHEN APPROPRIATE, WITHOUT UNDUE DELAY. WHEN NO 16 DECISION IS MADE ON A REQUEST TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR COVERED 17 SERVICES WITHIN TWENTY-ONE DAYS OF THE DATE THAT THE REQUEST IS 18 RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE AUTHORIZATION SHALL BE DEEMED 19 APPROVED. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL KEEP A RECORD OF THOSE CASES IN 20 WHICH NO DECISION IS MADE WITHIN TWENTY-ONE DAYS.

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
