## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the
- 2 approval of the Governor, to sell and convey two tracts of
- 3 land in the City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The Department of General Services, with the
- 7 approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of the
- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to sell the following described
- 9 tracts of land situate in the City of Philadelphia, County of
- 10 Philadelphia and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and
- 11 described as follows:
- 12 TRACT 1
- 13 All that certain lot or piece of ground situate and lying on
- 14 the southeast side of School House Lane and the northeast side
- 15 of The Oak Road in the 38th Ward of the City of Philadelphia,
- 16 County of Philadelphia, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,
- 17 described according to a survey or plan thereof made by W. F.
- 18 Wingate, Esq., Surveyor and Regulator of the 13th Survey
- 19 District of the City of Philadelphia on the 31st day of March,

- 1 1922, as follows, to wit:
- 2 Beginning at a point the intersection of the northeast side
- 3 of The Oak Road (50 feet wide) and the southeast side of School
- 4 House Lane (40 feet wide); thence along the said southeast side
- 5 of School House Lane (40 feet wide) north 66 degrees 00 minutes
- 6 52 seconds, east 226 feet 4 1/4 inches to a marble stone marking
- 7 the dividing line between property of the Germantown Friends
- 8 School and Henry W. Brown; thence along property belonging to
- 9 the Germantown Friends School formerly belonging to T. Wistar
- 10 Brown south 39 degrees 37 minutes 25 seconds, east 69 feet 00
- 11 inches to a point; thence at right angles to the last mentioned
- 12 property line along property belonging to Henry W. Brown of
- 13 which this is a part south 50 degrees 22 minutes 35 seconds,
- 14 west 212 feet 4 5/8 inches to a point in the northeast side of
- 15 The Oak Road (50 feet wide); thence along said northeast side of
- 16 The Oak Road by a line curving to the right with a radius of 836
- 17 feet, the distance of 40 feet 6 3/8 inches to the point of
- 18 tangent in the said northeast side of The Oak Road; thence
- 19 continuing along the said northeast side of The Oak Road north
- 20 41 degrees 39 minutes 8 seconds, west 89 feet 7 3/8 inches to
- 21 the first mentioned point and place of beginning, including in
- 22 said tract a proposed or existing 15 foot driveway along the
- 23 northeastern line of said lot and extending southeast to the Ivy
- 24 Cottage lot about 201 feet southeast of the southeast line of
- 25 the above described lot.
- 26 Containing 21,385.391 square feet and having erected thereon
- 27 a stone dwelling and detached two car garage known for street
- 28 address purposes as 3831 The Oak Road.
- 29 TRACT 2
- 30 All that certain lot or piece of ground in the 38th Ward of

- 1 the City of Philadelphia, situate on the northeasterly side of
- 2 The Oak Road, and described, as follows, to wit:
- 3 Beginning at a distance of 130 feet 1 3/4 inches
- 4 southeasterly from the southeast side of School House Lane 40
- 5 feet wide.
- 6 Containing in front or breadth on the said Oak Road 20 feet
- 7 and extending of that width in length between parallel lines
- 8 northeastwardly 212 feet 4 5/8 inches on the northwesterly line
- 9 and 210 feet 6 3/8 inches on the southeasterly line including in
- 10 said tract a proposed or existing 15 foot wide driveway along
- 11 the northeastern line of said lot and extending southeast to the
- 12 "Ivy Cottage" lot about 181 feet southeast of the southeast line
- 13 of the above described lot.
- 14 Being the same premises or tracts that Kathryn W. Stradley,
- 15 widow, by deed dated July 5, 1956 granted and conveyed to the
- 16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 17 Section 2. The Deed of Conveyance shall contain the
- 18 restriction that the tracts shall remain and only be used as a
- 19 single family residential dwelling.
- 20 Section 3. The Deed of Conveyance shall be approved by the
- 21 Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of
- 22 General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of
- 23 Pennsylvania.
- 24 Section 4. The sale price shall be determined by appraisal
- 25 by the Department of General Services and the tracts shall be
- 26 listed for sale by a realtor who regularly lists and sells real
- 27 estate in the area in which the tract is located.
- 28 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
