AN ACT

Amending the act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779, No.673), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to fish, frogs, tadpoles and turtles; and amending, revising, consolidating 3 and changing the law relating to fish in the inland waters and the boundary lakes and boundary rivers of the Commonwealth, providing for a reduced license fee for 7 certain disabled persons. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 220, act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779, 10 No.673), known as "The Fish Law of 1959," is amended by adding a 11 12 subsection to read: 13 Section 220. Resident Fishing Licenses; Fees. -- * * * 14 (b.1) Any person who was forced to retire from his regular occupation due to a disability shall be entitled to receive a 15 resident fishing license or at the election of said person a 16 lifetime senior resident fishing license pursuant to section 17 18 upon the completion of the requirements of subsection (a). The fee for a resident fishing license shall be the same as those 19 persons who are sixty-five or more years of age which is 20 provided for in subsection (a) or the fee of a lifetime senior 21
