AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779, No.673),
2 entitled, as amended, "An act relating to fish, frogs,
3 tadpoles and turtles; and amending, revising, consolidating
4 and changing the law relating to fish in the inland waters
5 and the boundary lakes and boundary rivers of the
6 Commonwealth," providing for a reduced license fee for
7 certain disabled persons.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 220, act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779,
11 No.673), known as "The Fish Law of 1959," is amended by adding a
12 subsection to read:

13 Section 220. Resident Fishing Licenses; Fees.--* * *

14 (b.1) Any person who was forced to retire from his regular
15 occupation due to a disability shall be entitled to receive a
16 resident fishing license or at the election of said person a
17 lifetime senior resident fishing license pursuant to section
18 upon the completion of the requirements of subsection (a). The
19 fee for a resident fishing license shall be the same as those
20 persons who are sixty-five or more years of age which is
21 provided for in subsection (a) or the fee of a lifetime senior

1 resident fishing license as provided in subsection (a).

2 * * *

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
