13 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE FEDERAL AUGMENTATION TO THE EXECUTIVE

16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
17 hereby enacts as follows:

7 SECTION 1. THIS ACT SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE <—
8 "SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1978."

9 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
10 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General
11 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, <—
12 ~~Legislative~~ and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the
13 payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel
14 expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees
15 of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services
16 rendered, for the purchase of rental of goods, services,
17 printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any
18 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
19 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
20 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period
21 beginning July 1, 1978 and for the payment of bills incurred and
22 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
23 30, 1978.

15 AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, IS HEREBY
16 SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED TO SUPPLEMENT THE SUM OF
17 \$9,667,000 APPROPRIATED FROM COMMONWEALTH REVENUES
18 FOR GENERAL GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS:

19 "SPECIAL FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS
20 AND CHILDREN" - TO PROVIDE IRON AND PROTEIN-RICH FOOD
21 TO LOW INCOME PREGNANT WOMEN, LACTATING MOTHERS
22 AND INFANTS AND CHILDREN (INCLUDING A CARRYOVER OF
23 APPROXIMATELY \$141,000)..... \$22,410,000

24 SECTION 3. IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT ANY
25 APPROPRIATION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT WHICH IS THE SAME
26 OR SIMILAR TO AN APPROPRIATION UNDER THE ACT OF MAY 31, 1978
27 (NO.16A), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE
28 EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE
29 COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR THE
30 FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1978 TO JUNE 30, 1979, AND FOR THE PAYMENT

1 OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE
2 FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1978," AS AMENDED, OR THE ACT OF
3 JULY 1, 1978 (NO.56A), ENTITLED "AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE
4 FEDERAL AUGMENTATION TO THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS
5 OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED RECEIPTS
6 ACCOUNTS FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1978 TO JUNE 30, 1979 AND
7 FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE
8 CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1978," OR THE ACT OF
9 MARCH 7, 1979 (NO.1A), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO FURTHER PROVIDE FOR
10 THE EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL
11 DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1,
12 1978 TO JUNE 30, 1979, AND TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS
13 FROM THE MOTOR LICENSE FUND; AND FROM THE FEDERAL AUGMENTATION
14 TO THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENTS FOR THE FISCAL
15 PERIOD JULY 1, 1978 TO JUNE 30, 1979," SHALL REPLACE SUCH
16 APPROPRIATIONS.

17 SECTION 4. THE ACT OF MAY 31, 1978 (NO.16A), KNOWN AS THE
18 "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1978," AS AMENDED, IS REPEALED
19 INsofar AS IT IS INCONSISTENT HERewith.

20 THE ACT OF JULY 1, 1978 (NO.56A), KNOWN AS THE "FEDERAL
21 AUGMENTATION APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1978," AS AMENDED, IS REPEALED
22 INsofar AS IT IS INCONSISTENT HERewith.

23 THE ACT OF MARCH 7, 1979 (NO.1A), KNOWN AS THE "SUPPLEMENTAL
24 APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1978," IS REPEALED INsofar AS IT IS
25 INCONSISTENT HERewith.

26 Section ~~3-~~ 5. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
