## AN ACT

Making appropriations from the State Employees' Retirement Fund to provide for expenses of the State Employees' Retirement Board for the fiscal period July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1980 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1979.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The following sums or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the state Employees' Retirement Fund to the State Employees' Retirement Board for the fiscal period beginning July 1,1979 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1979:
(1) The sum of $\$ 2,133,000$, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the employees and members of the State Employees' Retirement Board, for contractual services including the fees for mortgage supervision but exclusive of money management fees, and other expenses necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities of the
board and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June $30,1979$.
(2) The sum of $\$ 40,000$, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the development and integration of a computer control system for control over the security investments of the State Employees' Retirement Board.
(3) The sum of $\$ 300,000$, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the retention of present money management for the State Employees' Retirement Board.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
