11	(a) AgencyThe Supreme Court and all other agencies and
12	units of the unified judicial system when exercising the powers
13	to recommend or adopt general rules or other orders in the
14	nature of regulations shall be an agency within the meaning of
15	the act of July 19, 1974 (P.L.486, No.175), referred to as the
16	Public Agency Open Meeting Law.
17	(b) JurisdictionThe Supreme Court and all other courts of
18	the unified judicial system shall not have jurisdiction to
19	decide the validity or application of this section to the

1 judicial branch of government, either under the Constitution of

- 2 <u>Pennsylvania, or otherwise</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall 3
- 4 be retroactive to June 27, 1978.
