## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled 2 "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 3 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and 4 5 Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of 7 controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the 8 9 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and registrations; and repealing an act," requiring the labels on containers for prescription drugs to state the number of 10 11 pills or capsules therein. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. Section 8, act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and 16 17 Cosmetic Act," is amended by adding a clause to read: 18 Section 8. Misbranding. -- A controlled substance, other drug 19 or device or cosmetic shall be deemed to be misbranded: \* \* \* 20 21 (13) If it is a prescription controlled substance or drug in pill or capsule form, its retail container does not bear a label 22

stating the number of pills or capsules in the container.

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1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
