AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled 2 "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild 3 animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing Pennsylvania Game 5 Protectors and Deputy Game Protectors to use a hand-carried 6 flashing or rotating red light to stop and inspect vehicles. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 729.1, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, 9 10 No.316), known as "The Game Law," added June 11, 1976 (P.L.157, No.77), is amended to read: 11 12 Section 729.1. Flashing or Rotating Red Light. --Notwithstanding any provision of any other law to the contrary, 13 14 active full-time salaried Pennsylvania Game Protectors and 15 Deputy Game Protectors shall be authorized to operate or move 16 any official vehicle owned by the Commonwealth which is 17 identified or marked as such by appropriate lettering, decal, or both, as approved by the commission, upon any street or highway 18 within the Commonwealth, with a flashing or rotating red light 19

- 1 capable of being carried by hand or attached to such vehicle in
- 2 a temporary or permanent fashion which is visible in any
- 3 direction. The commission shall prescribe the type of flashing
- 4 or rotating red light to be used and the manner of attachment to
- 5 the vehicle.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
