## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 12, 1935 (P.L.677, No.255), entitled "An act to fix the status of officers and employes of the Commonwealth and political subdivisions thereof while in training with the armed forces of the United States," including reservists who are employed by the instrumentalities of the Commonwealth or its political subdivisions within the provisions of the act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of July 12, 1935 (P.L.677, No.255), entitled "An act to fix the status of officers and employes of the Commonwealth and political subdivisions thereof while in training with the armed forces of the United States," amended March 26, 1957 (P.L.17, No.10), is amended to read:

Section 1. [Be it enacted, \&c., That all] All officers and employes of the Commonwealth [of Pennsylvania, or of any political subdivision thereof,] or its instrumentalities, or any political subdivision thereof, or its instrumentalities, who are members, either enlisted or commissioned, of any reserve component of the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air

1 Force, or Coast Guard, shall be entitled to leave of absence 2 from their respective duties without loss of pay, time, or efficiency rating on all days not exceeding fifteen in any one

4 year during which they shall, as members of such reserve
5 components, be engaged in the active service of the United
6 States or in field training ordered or authorized by the Federal
7 forces.
8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
