5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. The song "Pennsylvania," the music and lyrics by
8	Mary E. Albert Attick of the City and County of Lebanon and
9	Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, is hereby adopted as the State
10	song of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and shall be the
11	official song for all public purposes. The lyrics are as

16	that loom so grand and tall,
17	Upon your hills and valleys

6	your ancestry is great,
7	In your bosom you have nurtured courage,

12	Pennsylvania, upon your beauteous land,
13	The Great Creator lifted His strong and kindly hand,

19	Pennsylvania, we hail you noble State
